



## Parade Contest Rules

### 2015 Parade Theme: “GAMES”

#### Awards Categories & Prizes:

1. Best Non-Profit Float: \$250 Grand Prize to Non-Profit Org & Trophy
2. Best Business Float: \$250 Grand Prize to be donated to Non-Profit of winners choice & Trophy
3. Best Individual/Group Entry: Trophy

#### Contest Eligibility\*:

1. In order to be entered into the judging for an award the Float **MUST** be decorated.
2. A “float” is defined as a trailer that is pulled by a tow vehicle.
3. Other entries (i.e. ambulances, fire trucks, forest service vehicles, classic cars, etc.) are welcome in the parade but **will not** be judged in the contest.
4. All entries **MUST** done and in the staging area by 10am on the day of the parade, entries need to register/check-in at the table located outside the Post Office on Davis Road.

#### Decorating Guidelines & Rules:

1. 2015 Parade Theme: Games
2. Create a float inspired by any game (board games, computer games, card games, etc.) Be as creative as possible.
3. Include the name of the game your float is inspired by somewhere on the float.
4. Include Bigfoot in some way (small or large, a picture or a footprint) for BONUS points!

#### Judging Criteria:

1. Recognizable to theme = Max of 5 points
2. Quality of Work = Max of 5 points
3. Originality = Max of 5 points
4. Bonus Points = Max of 3 points

\* For exceptions to these rules, please contact the Council. Exceptions will be granted on a case-by-case basis.

Winners will be announced at the Parade Awards Presentation at the River Park Pavilion on Sunday, September 6, 2015 at 12:30pm.
